We are an open-door shelter

We accept every animal, every day, 365 days/year. Even the ones whose health, age, or personality aren't ideal.

When an animal is turned away from "no-kill" shelters, an open-door shelter like CCSPCA is their only hope.



We are a private, non-profit business not a public agency. Nor are we affiliated with ASPCA or other SPCAs.

25,500 animals crossed our doors last year.

That's an average of 70 animals/day!

4,509 pets were adopted

1,120 animals were adopted though off-site locations/events.



We provide dogs free of charge to service dog agencies for search & rescue, law enforcement, & to assist citizens with disabilities.



In addition to being a Humane Society we also perform Animal Control services for the City of Fresno by way of contract.



We have responded to 711 investigative complaints of cruelty/neglect, 56 cases of health/safety, & 136 cases of pets locked in cars. 3 cases were filed with the DA's Office.

Animal Control Officers respond to approximately 17,000 calls/year.



Our organization received over 287,000 calls.

CCSPCA & our Pet Placement Organizations (PPO) have sent many dogs out of state for placement, including Canada, Chicago, Oregon, & Montana. 2,355 animals were transferred to PPOs.

We offer educational opportunities such as site tours, special meeting presentations, summer camp, jr. programs, dog safety classes for businesses/professionals, educational booths at community events, group volunteering, service learning projects for students & much more.



Our Education Department

visits schools in all 32 school districts in Fresno County & other Central Valley locations.

Free courses offered to schools/nonprofits include

We employ approximately 91 compassionate & dedicated staff members in 1 location, ranging all the way to 46 years of service. 30% of our employees have been with CCSPCA for 5+ years!



1,370 animals were placed in our Foster Care program.

Last fiscal year 653 individuals & 561 group volunteers gave 18,483 hours of service.



Our Low-Cost Vaccine Clinic

vaccinated 2,844 animals for rabies. In total, 6,807 vaccinations were given to dogs & cats.

Our Spay/Neuter Services Team

performed 3,977 spay/neuter surgeries for adopted animals.

We performed 287 spays/neuters on client owned non-adopted animals.

1,866 additional Spay/Neuter surgeries were performed for our partnering rescues.
